There is less availability during evenings and weekends.

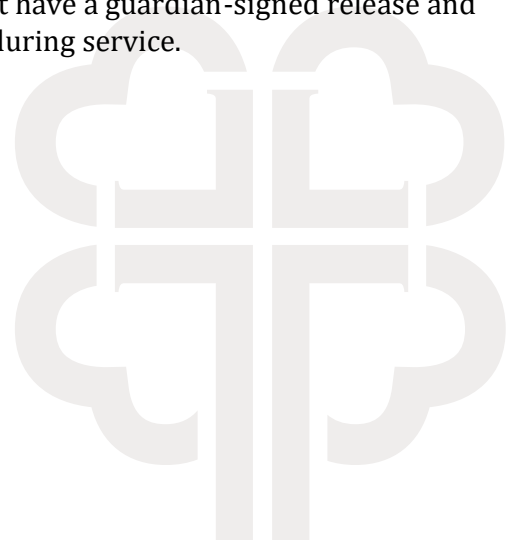

Spiritual Activities

Help LSS residents live a rich spiritual life! Volunteers are needed to transport our seniors to and from their rooms to chapel, devotions, bible study, communion, etc. Volunteers may also greet residents, read scripture, share musical talents, assist with hymnals, etc. We welcome all denominations. Service times vary by community but are often on Sundays.

Resident Assistant/Transporter

Our residents have places to go and things to do...sometimes they just need a helping hand getting there. Volunteers assist them from their rooms to other places on the property such as the health clinic, beauty shop, therapy, and activity room. Duties may include pushing a wheelchair or providing a steady arm.

- Volunteers who serve on a regular basis (more than six times in a year) must complete an application and background check, attend orientation/training, and have a TB skin test if volunteering more than 10 hours per week in a licensed area. **Other vaccinations may be required based on a volunteer's specific role.*
- Youth volunteers are welcome! Minors under 18 must have a guardian-signed release and youth under 14 must be accompanied by a guardian during service.
- Must be able to push a wheelchair.

Hidden Gems Resale Shop Staffer

Spend some time among the hidden gems donated to our resale shop while also helping raise funds that provide financial assistance to seniors. This position is perfect for the person who loves to interact with a variety of people and would enjoy receiving, pricing, and organizing donations. The store is located on Watson Rd. in St. Louis and is open Tuesday through Saturdays from 10am to 6pm. Shifts are generally four hours in length.

- Volunteers must complete an application and background check, and attend orientation/training.
- Volunteers must be at least 18 years old.

Hospice

Caring and compassionate volunteers are needed to provide companionship to hospice patients and serve their families and caregivers by providing respite care. Other unique volunteer roles may also include pet visits, veteran programming, vigil volunteering, and administrative tasks. This position is available in the St. Louis metro area only.

- Volunteers must complete an application and background check, attend orientation/training, and have a TB skin test.
- Volunteers must be at least 18 years old.

Volunteer Money Management

Help keep seniors independent in their own homes! Volunteers provide individualized, in-home, confidential money management assistance to adults over age 60 or individuals over age 50 with a disability. The average time commitment is 2 hours per month. Service areas include St. Louis, St. Charles, and Jefferson counties in Missouri and St. Clair county in Illinois.

- Volunteers must complete an application and background check, and attend orientation/training.
- Volunteers must be at least 21 years old.

Senior Connections

Aging can be lonely...but it doesn't have to be! Volunteers trained as relational visitors bring brighter days and companionship to seniors. This position is currently available in St. Louis and St. Charles counties.

- Volunteers must complete an application and background check, and attend orientation/training.
- Volunteers must be at least 18 years old.

Office Support

Be a part of our in-house team. Volunteers assist LSS staff with administrative duties such as making copies, assisting with mailings, answering phones, and stocking shelves.

- Volunteers must complete an application and background check, and attend orientation/training.

Landscaping/Gardening

Have a green thumb and time to spare? Volunteers are needed to assemble raised beds, for planting, weeding, and general maintenance. Spring and Fall are especially times of need.
